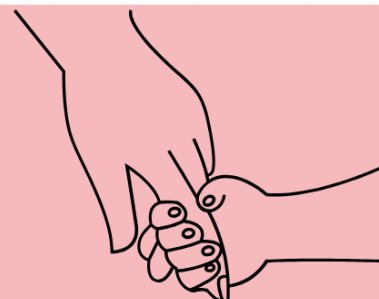


BLENDED INTENSIVE PROGRAM ON CHILDHOOD MALTREATMENT
