THE RECTOR

- Whereas** the Statute of Libera Università Maria Ss. Assunta, issued by Rector's Decree No. 2582 of 12 May 2022 and published in the Italian Official Gazette (Gazzetta Ufficiale) No. 119 of 23 May 2022;
- Whereas** article 30 of the Academic Regulations of Libera Università Maria Ss. Assunta, issued by Rector's Decree No. 2885 of 22 November 2023, as subsequently amended;
- Whereas** the General University Regulations, issued by Rector's Decree No. 1717 of 28 October 2016, as subsequently amended and supplemented;
- Whereas** the University Erasmus Regulations, issued by Rector's Decree No. 1901 of 22 March 2018;

DECREES

A comparative selection procedure is **HEREBY ANNOUNCED** for the selection of **15 students** to participate in the “Blended Intensive Programme (BIP)” entitled “*European Regulation for the Digital, Green and Demographic Transition*”, which will be hosted by **LUMSA, Rome Campus**.

Art. 1_ Programme Delivery

Selected participants will be required to take part in both the online and the in-person components of the programme on the following dates:

Online: 01/09/2026

In-person: from 06/09/2026 to 11/09/2026

Participation in the BIP will entitle students to obtain 3 CFU/ECTS credits, which may be recognised within their study programme in accordance with the regulations governing their degree course. Participation in this activity does not entitle students to the award of any additional points towards their final degree grade.

Art. 2_ Eligibility Requirements

Applications are open to all students who meet the following requirements:

- students enrolled at LUMSA for the 2025/2026 academic year in a Master's Degree Programme or in the fourth or fifth year of a Single-Cycle Master's Degree Programme within the GEPLI Department.

Art. 3_ Selection Criteria

The ranking will be drawn up on the basis of a maximum score of 30 points, awarded according to the following criteria:



- **CFU credits** earned by the application deadline, divided by 15 (up to a maximum of 6 points);
- **Weighted average grade**, expressed out of 30, of the registered examination marks as of the application deadline, divided by 2.5 (up to a maximum of 8 points);
- **Curriculum Vitae** in English (up to a maximum of 8 points);
- **Motivation letter**, in which the applicant outlines the reasons for their interest in the initiative and its relevance to their degree programme (up to a maximum of 8 points).

In the event of a tie, the younger student will be selected.

Art. 4_ Application Form

The Application Form (Annex A), drafted on plain paper and bearing the applicant's original handwritten signature, must be submitted by email to erasmuslumsa@lumsa.it no later than **20 July 2026 at 12:00 noon**, under penalty of exclusion from the comparative selection procedure, specifying in the subject line: **“Application for participation in the BIP – Master’s Degree Programmes and Single-Cycle Master’s Degree Programme, GEPLI Department”**.

The application form (Annex A) must be submitted together with the language certificate, as specified in Article 3.

Art. 5_ Selection Committee

The Selection Committee, composed of three members, shall draw up the merit ranking in descending order of the points awarded to the candidates. The ranking will be published on the following website: <https://lumsa.it/it/international/mobilita-per-studenti/blended-intensive-programme>
